How to make a Lunch Order

Orders must be placed with the Canteen before 9.15am

THE CANTEEN IS CLOSED ON TUESDAY - NO LUNCH ORDERS OR WINDOW SALES

- The Canteen staff want to ensure that your child gets the correct items, and any change due to them. Please help us by putting all the necessary details on your order, regardless if it is on a lunch bag, envelope, or even a piece of paper.

ON THE OUT SIDE OF BAG PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY -

1. The Childs name.
2. The Childs room number.
3. The Order
4. The amount of money enclosed in the order.

RE-USABLE LUNCH BAGS ARE AVAILABLE TO PURCHASE FROM THE CANTEEN FOR \$10.00

- * Sticky tape is handy when using an envelope or paper to ensure coins don't go missing, but **PLEASE DO NOT TAPE UP LUNCH BAGS** - (4 - 5 small folds works well)
 - * It is important to fill out a **separate order for each of your children**. You can put all of the money in one bag, but please indicate what you have done on **each** order. On the bag with all the money write the amounts for **each order** and the total.
 - * You can only order items that are on the price list
 - * If your child has any problems with their lunch order -(missing item, wrong change etc.) please encourage them to come to the canteen as soon as they realise the problem. It is much easier to sort out any problems on the same day.
 - * **Hot food is not available for Morning Play.**
 - * Paper bags from the Canteen cost 10 cents each
 - * There is a surcharge of 10c on re-usable cups. 10c will be refunded when the cup is returned to the Canteen.
 - * **LUNCH MUST BE ORDERED.** The Canteen does not sell lunch items at the Window
- The Canteen welcomes any suggestions you may have. Please write them down and pass them on, or come in and see me.
- If you want to help out in the Canteen, please feel free to come and see me anytime, help is always welcome. ☺
